Welcome to Family Spirit!

Thank you for taking the time to learn about our Family Spirit Program. We are excited to share the trainings that are available to support home-visitors working in Indigenous and diverse communities. Included in this catalog are training descriptions, eligibility criteria, and important 2025 dates for the upcoming year.

CORE CURRICULUM TRAINING

Trainees will learn basic home visiting skills and how to deliver the 65 Family Spirit Core lessons. Currently, there are three certificate types offered for Family Spirit Training that include: 1) Health Educator 2) Supervisor and 3) Refresher.

For certified Family Spirit Health Educators and Supervisors, refresher training provides the opportunity to keep their curriculum and implementation skills current, review updated curriculum concepts, and reconnect with Family Spirit affiliate sites across the country. This training can also benefit Health Educators who haven't used Family Spirit often or for those transitioning into a new FS Supervisor role within their organization.

Starting in 2023, we recommend all Family Spirit Health Educators and Supervisors complete a Refresher Training every two years.

Training:

- PRE-TRAINING
 - KICK-OFF MEETING: Mandatory 3-hour virtual meeting
 - Independent/On-Demand Content: 20-24 hours of coursework
- CORE TRAINING
 - IN-PERSON: 8-HOURS PER DAY FOR 4 DAYS OVER 1 WEEK
 - Virtual: 6-hours per day for 5 days over 1 week
- POST TRAINING
 - 6 monthly 1-hour virtual sessions following core training with FS Liaison

Eligibility and Criteria:

- FS Health Educator/Supervisor Certificate: Must be a current or onboarding Family Spirit affiliate site
- FS Refresher: Must be a certified Family Spirit Health Educator AND work at a site that is actively implementing the Family Spirit curriculum

FAMILY SPIRIT HOME VISITING PROGRAM TRAININGS AVAILABLE IN 2025

SOCIAL SUPPORT VISIT TRAINING

Thank you for taking the time to learn about our Family Spirit Program. We are excited to share the trainings that are available to support home-visitors working in Indigenous and diverse communities. Included in this catalog are training descriptions, eligibility criteria, and important 2025 dates for the upcoming year.

As part of efforts to provide Home Visitors with more tools to support mental health, we are offering training on the newly developed Social Support Visit Structure (SSVS). This step-by-step SSVS is an alternative home visit structure developed to support families experiencing a crisis or distress preventing their participation in the planned curriculum lesson. The SSVS Training will be provided concurrently the same week of Core Training. All trainees have the option of attending SSVS and Thrive Training during the same week.

Things to know about the FS SSVS:

- Based on principles of Psychological First Aid
- · Aims to help Home Visitors respond confidently and in a more standardized way
- Practice for Home Visitors needing to pivot from planned curriculum lesson
- Reviews a range of screening tools to assess safety and identify the need for specific kinds of referrals
- Provides Home Visitors with self-care references when they're completing this work

Training Overview:

- PRE-TRAINING
 - KICK-OFF MEETING: <u>Mandatory</u>
 1.5-hour meeting via Zoom
 - Independent Work: Self Assessments
- CORE TRAINING
 - IN-PERSON: 8-HOURS PER DAY FOR 2 DAYS
- POST-TRAINING
 - One post-training call and quarterly check-ins with liaison
 - Report SSVS data in the Quarterly Affiliate Report

Eligibility and CRITERIA:

- Be a certified Family Spirit Home Visitor/Health Educator who has been conducting home visits with families (prenatal and/or with children ages 0-5) for at least 4 months
- Work at actively implementing Family Spirit affiliate site
- Have the full knowledge and support of your program supervisor
- Supervisors are required to participate in the virtual Kick-Off Meeting and one pre-training planning call. We strongly encourage direct supervisors to also attend the in-person training.

TRAININGS AVAILABLE IN 2025

THRIVE CURRICULUM TRAINING

Thank you for your interest in this highly anticipated Family Spirit Thrive Training! The Family Spirit Home Visiting Program has extended the curricular content to families with children 3-5 years old. We are excited to announce available training descriptions, eligibility criteria, and important 2025 dates for the upcoming year.

Trainees will first be introduced to the new module and its concepts which build upon skills learned from the Core Curriculum Training. An in-depth review of the curriculum, which offers 20 lessons consisting of 8 Core Lessons and 12 Pathway Lessons, will be provided concurrently the same week of Core Training. All trainees have the option of attending Social Support Visit Structure and Thrive.

FS Thrive is intended to support and encourage:

- Connections to Indigenous culture, traditions and language
- The whole wellness of a child and their family
- Caregivers and parents learning alongside their children
- The importance of connection with extended family, community, and environment
- Early learning concepts that are present in everyday life

<u>Training:</u>

- PRE-TRAINING
 - Kick-Off Meeting: Mandatory 1-hour meeting via Zoom
 - o Independent/On-Demand Content: 10-hours total of content review
- CORE TRAINING
 - The in-person Core Training phase is scheduled in-person over 2 full days
- POST-TRAINING
 - o One-Post Training meeting followed by Quarterly Check-Ins with FS Liaison
 - Reporting of basic Family Spirit Thrive data in Quarterly Affiliate Report

- Be a certified Family Spirit Home Visitor/Health Educator who has been conducting home visits with families (prenatal and/or with children ages 0-5) for at least 4 months
- Work at actively implementing Family Spirit affiliate site

- Enter into contract with JHU CIH at least 4 months prior to core training date
- Submit payment to JHU CIH 2 months prior to core training date


